The following information indicates how you can participate in this community event.

DONATED ITEMS FOR PEACE TO SELL:

Please drop items off anytime after worship on Sunday May 20 and before 5 pm on Weds., June 13.

If you desire a receipt for your donation please list items on a Donation Sheet available at church and Peace will acknowledge your donation with its signature. *See item number 7 below for item restrictions.* Any unsold donated goods *must be removed* at end of sale on the day of sale unless other arrangements have been made with event coordinators or Pastor Debbie Conklin. Items not purchased or picked up will be given to Goodwill.

Peace reserves the right to refuse and/or remove any items deemed inappropriate.

CONSIGNED ITEMS FOR PEACE TO SELL are WELCOME:

Consigned items valued at \$50 or more each will be accepted by Peace to sell at 50% of the selling price. *See item number 7 below for item restrictions.* Any unsold donated goods *must be removed* at end of sale on the day of sale unless other arrangements have been made with event coordinators or Pastor Debbie Conklin. Items not purchased or picked up will be given to Goodwill.

Peace reserves the right to refuse and/or remove any items deemed inappropriate.

BOOTH PARTICIPANTS (Vendors)

1. A 12'x12' outdoor area (booth) rents for **\$10.00**. A similar size indoor area booth rents for **\$15.00**. You may rent as many outdoor booths as you need pending availability. You may rent only one booth indoors and first come, first served with payment will secure indoor booths. Outdoor booths will have more visibility and likely more traffic. You may share a booth with someone else.

Registration DEADLINE: Monday, June 11, Please email <u>pastordeb@peacechurchbg.org</u> or call 419-352-0241 to arrange a convenient time to register. *See Registration Form*

Booth rent due at sign-up, and table rent on the day of sale. You may use your own tables or rent *up to three* 8' foot tables per booth from Peace at the cost of \$10 a table.

2. Vendors are not permitted to sell prepared food or drink for human consumption. Peace Church will have cold water on hand.

3. Vendor set-up time is from 6:00am (daybreak) until 7:45am on the day of the sale. You may pull your car up to your booth to unload but you must move it to the vendors' parking area by 7:30am.

4. Vendors are responsible for all aspects of your participation: setting up and taking down tables and displays, bringing items to and arranging your booth, pricing, selling and wrapping goods, and collecting money from *your* sales.

5. Peace volunteers will be on hand to provide brief breaks to vendors as needed.

6. The church building will be open for water and use of bathrooms. There is no electric access for use at the sale. You may bring food for your own consumption however no refrigeration will be available so bring your own cooler if refrigeration is needed.

7. Vendors may want to bring some clear plastic clothes in the event of rain or high wind. (*clear allows hardy flea market patrons shop regardless of the weather!*) Covering your tables with a plain or colored sheet or tablecloth is recommended as well. Goods appear more inviting displayed on covered tables. Other supplies that have proven to come in handy are pen/pencil, paper or writing pad, string, tape (duct and Scotch), safety pins, and an apron with pockets for making change.

8. You may sell what you wish with the exception of the following: prepared food or drink for human consumption, live animals, bedding, hazardous or dangerous items, large appliances, building materials, large upholstered furniture, or pornographic material. *Peace reserves the right to require you to remove any items deemed inappropriate.*

9. Keep in mind buyers have been known to show up earlier than posted start time! How you handle the early birds is up to you.

10. Peace Church will likely put its items at $\frac{1}{2}$ price at NOON and free at 1 p.m. There is no expectation that you do the same and Peace will do its best to communicate that this pertains to Peace booth only.
